On Sunday, August 24 we will have a special collection time during our service for the rice bowls.

World Hunger Offering

Our approach to the World Hunger offering will be different this year. The Women’s Ministry will provide a rice bowl for each family. The purpose of the rice bowls is to focus on feeding people all over the world. Many countries within Africa and the Middle East have been dealing with drought-stricken issues for some time. Rice bowls will be available this Sunday, August 3 in the Missions Room. We are asking that each family put loose change into the rice bowl through most of the month of August. On Sunday, August 24 we will be asking you to bring your bowl to the worship service for a special emphasis on world hunger. If you would prefer not to use the rice bowl, the world hunger offering will be taken through August 24. The World Hunger Offering is not included in our First On Missions Offering.

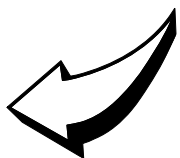
