




FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH FIRST FLOOR **3rd Street**

RE-GATHERING GUIDELINES

Even as our Sunday School classes have taken advantage of virtual and off-campus opportunities during this global pandemic, meeting in person is vitally important to carry out the disciple-making purpose of the Sunday School ministry. As our classes begin meeting on campus again, there are important guidelines for our congregation to follow during this unique time of re-gathering.

Schedule

All of the on-campus classes (all ages) will meet at 9:45am on Sunday.

Entrance/Exit

On Sunday mornings, three entrances will be made available to enter the building. The ramp door on Daviess Street, the main building entrance on J.R. Miller Blud., and the reception door in our back parking lot. Please reference the maps for these locations. At each of these entrances, temperature checks will be conducted along with providing masks for those needing one. Each of the doors in our building will be available to exit at any time, but re-entrance will only be allowed at the designated locations.

Hallways/Transitions

When walking in the hallways of the buildings, please attempt to maintain appropriate distance between yourself (your family group) and others. Please utilize the right side of the hallways to assist with distancing. Also, when dropping off/picking up children from their classes, follow the traffic-flow guidelines for those areas, as they are prone to crowding. Ultimately, exercise respect for and patience with one another in the transitioning process!

Classrooms

From preschool through senior adults, classes will be placed in new rooms, which will be arranged to best utilize space and observe proper distancing. Adjustments to the seating arrangements inside each classroom are welcomed to accommodate couples and family groups. The provided directory and maps identify the new locations for each class. Please know that each classroom is sanitized prior to use each week, and continued sanitation will take place in preschool/children areas even during the use of the room. Additionally, flexibility is much appreciated from all groups as the room situation will be fluid with classes having varying levels of participants return to campus in person.

Restrooms

All restrooms will be made available beginning with the Sunday School re-gathering phase. Please continue to observe proper distancing guidelines in these areas as well.

- Wash hands and/or utilize hand sanitizer often.
