The Purpose of Sunday School

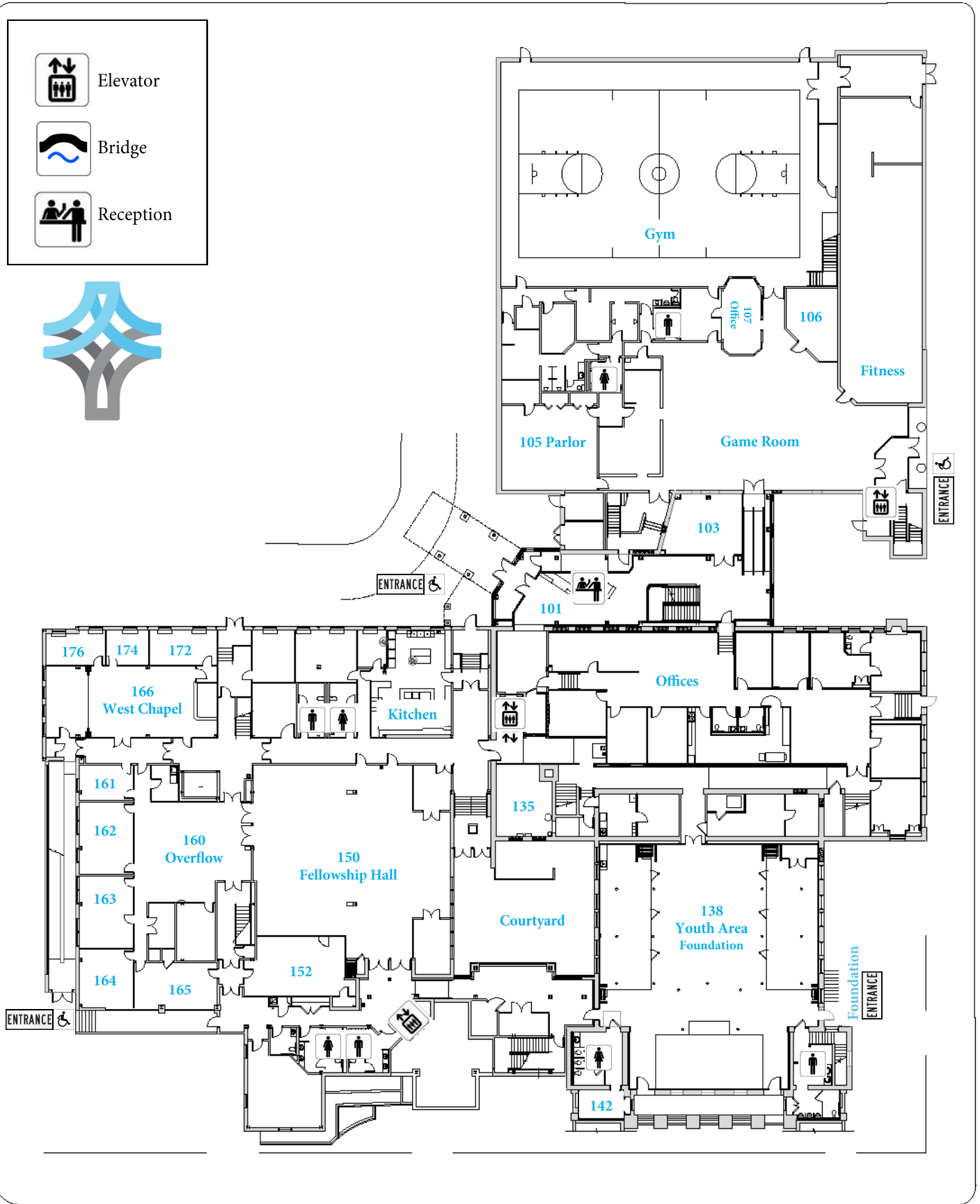

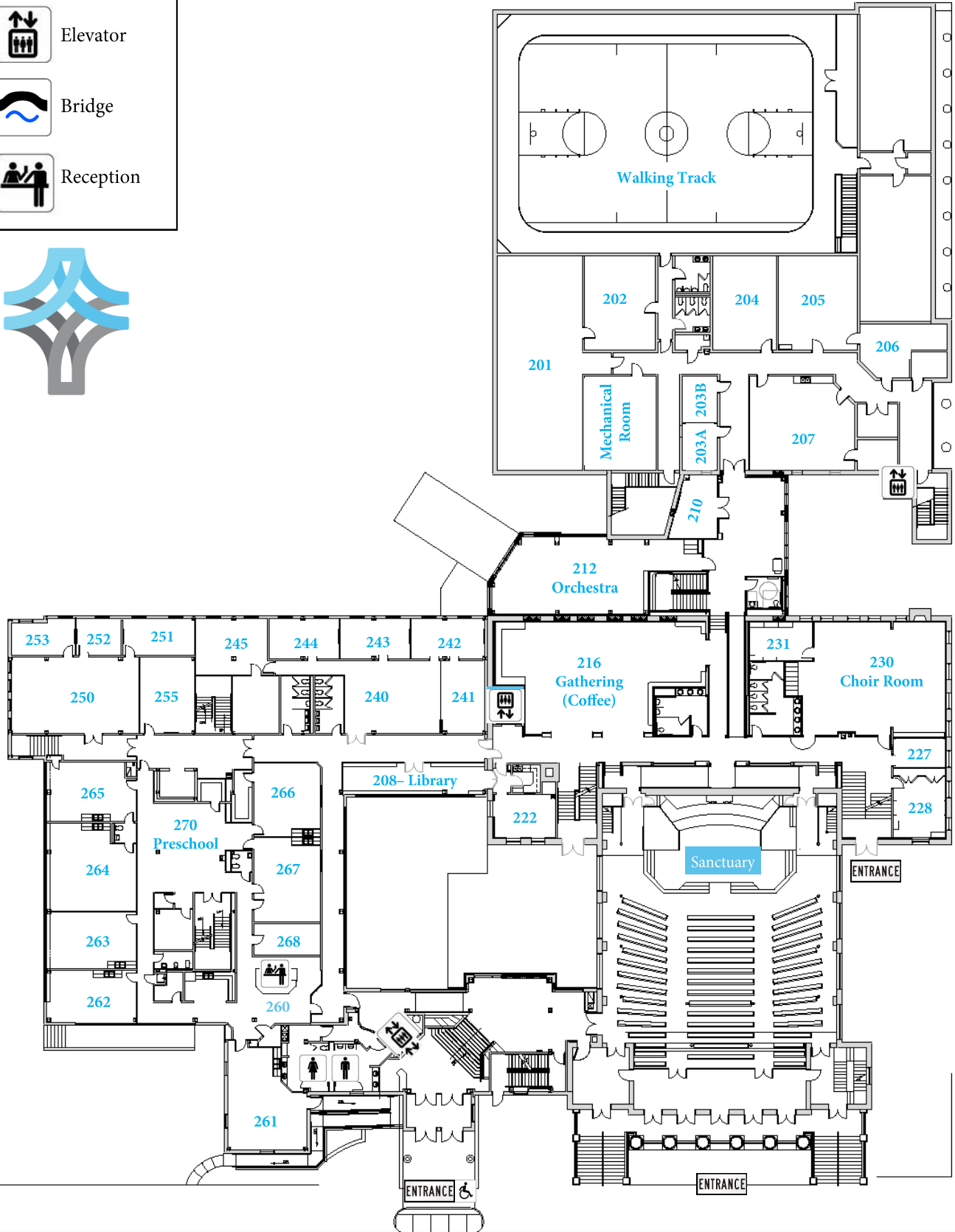

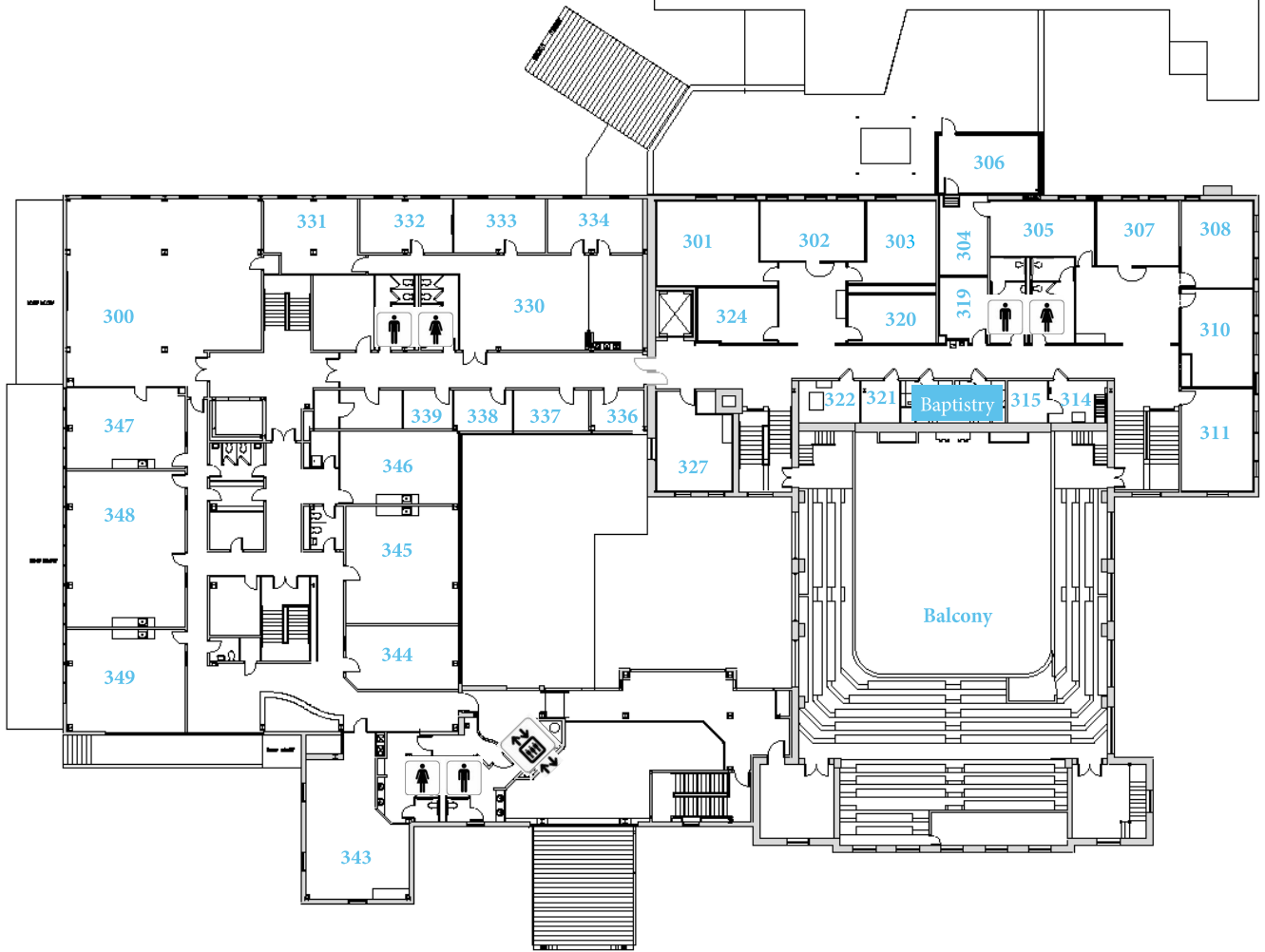
